
One of the important rules to be followed by a Muslim is to be physically clean. The Prophet (PBUH) taught Muslims, through his tradition, how to maintain physical cleanliness.

Muslims should follow these rules:

- 1. When I enter, I say,"Bism Allah, I seek refuge in Allah from filth and filthy objects."
- 2. I go into the bathroom with my left foot first.






Islamic Etiquette for Using the Washroom

- 3. I need to cover myself while I am urinating or defecating.
- 4. I should not speak while I am urinating or defecating.
- 5. I use my left hand to wash my private body parts after urinating or defecating.

Beware!

Urine and bowl are both filthy objects. They defile any place or object they come in contact with. One should wash his/her private body parts after visiting the bathroom. After that one should wash his/her hands.

6. One should leave the bathroom using his right foot first.





7. Coming out of the bathroom, I should say, "I seek Allah's forgiveness."



- His grandfather became his guardian after his mother died. His grandfather died when he was eight years old.
- When his grandfather died, his uncle Abu Taleb became his guardian. He was raised with his cousins.
- Prophet Muhammad (PBUH) became a Sheppard when he was a boy.
- When he grew up, he became a trader. He always told the truth and he was trustworthy. People used to entrust him with their valuables. He earned the nickname, "The truthful, the trustworthy."
